 - v. United Nations Convention Against Torture and Other Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment (1984)
 - vi. United Nations Principals for the protection of all Persons under any form of Detention or Imprisonment (1988)
 - vii. United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (1989)
 - viii. UNESCO Cultural Diversity Charter (date?)
